I want to take this opportunity to express our support for the California High-Speed Rail Authority's (CHSRA) Revised Draft 2020 Business Plan (the "Draft Plan").

The Transbay Joint Powers Authority (TJPA) commends the CHSRA for completing the Draft Plan and continuing to advance this important project. TJPA is pleased to support the CHSRA in delivering high speed rail service to the new multimodal Salesforce Transit Center in downtown San Francisco to create seamless connections among local, regional, and statewide transportation systems under one roof. This would include 10 other transit systems: AC Transit, BART, Caltrain, Golden Gate Transit, Muni, SamTrans, WestCAT Lynx, Amtrak, Paratransit, and Greyhound.

After 20 years of planning, and nearly ten years of construction, the Salesforce Transit Center is open, and your support has been instrumental. You have been a true champion for public transit and for ensuring San Francisco Bay Area residents can live closer to work, reduce commute times, and increase their quality of life. We believe that the delivery of High-Speed Rail into downtown San Francisco to the Salesforce Transit Center will be a transformational project of regional, state, and national importance.
