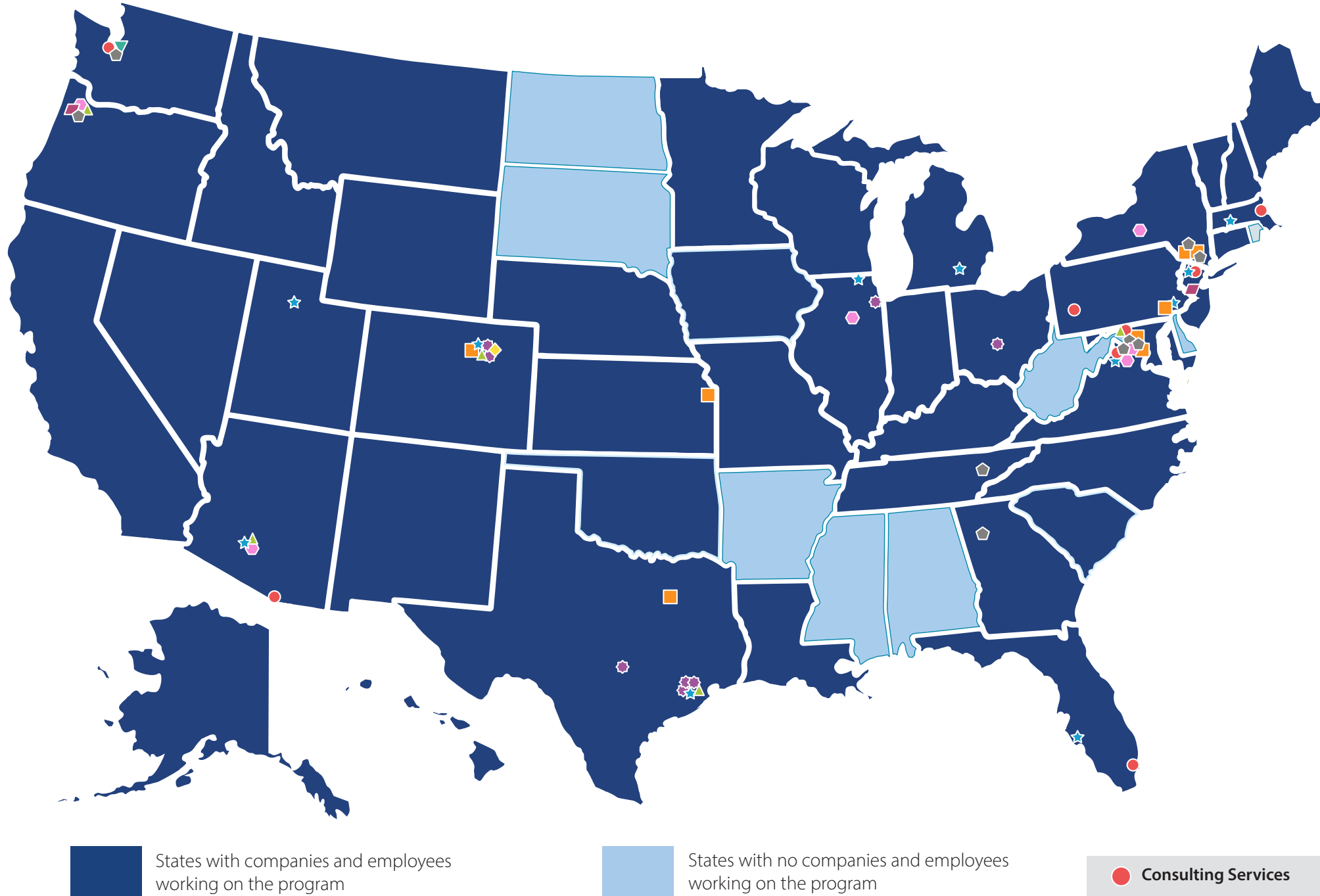




California High-Speed Rail's National Impact

As of June 2020, the California High-Speed Rail Program has invested **\$195.6 million** outside California.
