

10 DRAFT EIR/EIS DISTRIBUTION

Distribution of the Palmdale to Burbank Project Section Draft Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS) emphasizes the use of electronic media to ensure cost-effective, broad availability to the public and interested parties.

The Draft EIR/EIS (Volume 1), technical appendices (Volume 2), and alignment plans (Volume 3) comprising the entire Draft EIR/EIS are available on the California High-Speed Rail Authority's web site (https://hsr.ca.gov/). Electronic copies of the entire Draft EIR/EIS are available at no cost to all members of the public upon request at the office of the California High-Speed Rail Authority (700 L Street, Suite 800, Sacramento, CA 95814) and its Southern California regional office (355 South Grand Avenue, Suite 2050, Los Angeles, CA 90071).¹ Paper copies of the three-volume Draft EIR/EIS will be available at the California High-Speed Rail Authority offices. Volume 1 of the Draft EIR/EIS may be reviewed in hard copy at select public libraries in the project vicinity (listed in Section 10.1). Copies of the three-volume Draft EIR/EIS also may be accessed at the repository libraries (open days/hours may be reduced for compliance with COVID-19 public health and safety directives). In consideration of the COVID-19 pandemic, please refer to the Authority's website for the latest information regarding availability of the document.

All persons, agencies, and organizations listed in Sections 10.2 through 10.8 of this chapter have been informed of the availability of and locations to obtain the entire Draft EIR/EIS, as well as the timing of the formal comment period. Notice of availability of the entire Draft EIR/EIS has been included in the *Federal Register* in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Repositories and cooperating federal agencies were sent both paper and electronic copies of the Draft EIR/EIS in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and NEPA. Electronic copies were filed with the California State Clearinghouse in compliance with CEQA and through the e-NEPA electronic filing system in compliance with NEPA and its implementing regulations.

Los Angeles County received an electronic copy of the entire Draft EIR/EIS. All federal agencies, state agencies, and selected interested parties listed below in Sections 10.2 through 10.8 received a paper copy of the Summary chapter and electronic copies of the entire Draft EIR/EIS in compliance with CEQA and NEPA. The Executive Summary has been translated into the primary languages used throughout the Palmdale to Burbank area, including Spanish, Armenian, and Arabic. Federal, state, and county elected officials, mayors of cities with proposed stations, and the potentially affected local agencies listed below were mailed a fact sheet and instructions on how to access a copy of the entire Draft EIR/EIS. Additional local elected officials, agency representatives, and all others on the project mailing list have been mailed a notification that includes information about how to access the entire Draft EIR/EIS; the timing of the formal comment period; and public hearing dates, times, and locations. Property owners and building occupants within or nearby the Build Alternative footprints have also received information regarding the Draft EIR/EIS. Notification of the availability of the Draft EIR/EIS and the times and locations of community open houses and public hearings was also distributed through the California High-Speed Rail Authority's social media accounts, the HSR website (https://hsr.ca.gov/), and by email distribution to individuals who provided email addresses for the project mailing list.
